

CODE OF CONDUCT 2024

At TAMDE, our aim is to train the individual, not only in the practice of their chosen art form, but also in the essential "skills for life" which are necessary for success in any profession, not only the arts.

For this training to be effective there is a Code of Conduct prescribed by this training establishment, in the interests of producing the best long term results for both the parents and the students.

Students enrolling at TAMDE are expected to follow the Code of Conduct prescribed.

PERSONAL PRESENTATION

All students at TAMDE are required to wear the prescribed listed dance attire for all classes.

Hair is to be neatly arranged, and for dance/acro students bound close to the head. It is expected that students show respect for teachers and fellow students by being clean and tidy for class. Shoes, socks and tights should be clean at all times.







PUNCTUALITY: Students should make every effort to be on time for classes, especially the higher level dance classes, which require a minimum 15 minute warm-up in the interests of injury prevention. If late for class, the student should excuse themselves before taking their place in class. If a student is going to be missing from class, we request that the parent sends a message to us before the start time of class. This is so we know your child is safe and the whereabouts are known to you as a parent/guardian. Your child is welcome to make this lesson up by joining another class.

If a student is going to miss a private lesson, the teacher involved will need at least 6 hours notice, or the fee for the private lesson will still apply.

We do understand sickness, family circumstances and accidents. Please do not ever put your family at risk by rushing to class. We do understand that things do happen. **COURTESY**: Students and parents are expected to show respect/manners and courtesy to all in our studio. Please note: we do have our Steps/Anti Bullying program that is implemented in our studios. Signs and copies are available

at the studio.



REHEARSAL AND CLASS WORK ETHIC:



Concentration and focus are an essential part of the learning process. For this reason, students are expected to pay due attention in class at all times. If a student is sick, or has any type of injury then they must advise the teacher immediately, and they will be excused.

EXAMINATIONS:

We offer Ballet (RAD), Tap, Modern Jazz, Contemporary, Musical Theatre (ComDance) and Drama (Trinity College)
Certificate 111 in Assistant Dance Teaching (ATOD)
Certificate 4 in Dance Teaching & Business Management (ATOD)

Examinations and certificate classes are not compulsory.
Students who would like to sit an examination in their chosen discipline will be required to attend the scheduled holiday workshops. Comdance: Easter Holidays, RAD: June/July Holidays. Dates are listed on our important dates page.

Please note: An exam uniform will need to be purchased. A note will be handed out for all exam uniform requirements and orders closer to the exam time.

These will be handled by the studio.

We like to take as much pressure off the parents as possible.





Eisteddfod group work is the equivalent of a representative sports team. Teams are not efficient/successful if members miss training. In fairness to those who do attend, students who miss more than 3 rehearsals (We do understand personal or severe illness reasons) in any term will be excluded from the competition group and will have to wait until the Showcase at the end of the year to perform with the group. Eisteddfods are not compulsory. You will be provided with a group acceptance form throughout the year for you to make your decision. You're more than welcome to only participate in the end of year Showcase. Nothing is compulsory at TAMDE.

Students will be handed group acceptance forms during Term 2. Yourself and your child are able to accept a position in the groups marked for your child.

Costume deposit forms will then be issued so you're able to break up the payment of costumes.







EISTEDDFOD

All students who are participating in Eisteddfod groups that require rehearsals at the MECC will be required to pay a fee of \$40.50per student competing in only one group. \$62.50 per student competing in more than one group. This fee is attached to the group costume deposit fees.

FRIDAY 20TH SEPTEMBER - FRIDAY 27TH SEPTEMBER
These are compulsory lessons for our competition groups.
SOLOS/DUOS/TRIOS: Students do have options to learn solos/duos/trios for upcoming competitions. Please ask for a solo/duo/trio form upon registration. Students will be given many opportunities to learn routines from many different choreographers. Students must be registered with TAMDE before learning and performing any routines taught. No routines will be started until solo/duo/trio form has been filled in, signed and returned.

PLEASE NOTE: 6HRS NOTICE MUST BE GIVEN TO THE APPROPRIATE TEACHER IF STUDENT IS UNABLE TO ATTEND LESSON. IF APPROPRIATE TIME IS NOT GIVEN PAYMENT FOR THAT MISSED LESSON MUST BE HONOURED AND GIVEN TO APPROPRIATE TEACHER. WE DO UNDERSTAND EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.
